

RULES & CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT: MARCH 2, 2018

The Kansas Academy of Family Physicians–Foundation (KAFP-F) is currently seeking submissions from medical students, residents, and fellows for Poster Presentations on June 16, 2018, during KAFP’s Annual Meeting. The purpose of the presentation is to:

- Promote scholarly activity among medical students, family medicine residents, and fellows
- Provide a venue for recognition of original work
- Provide quality education at the KAFP Annual Meeting

REQUIREMENTS:

- Posters presentations may be either a research project, case report or literature review.
- Posters should address a topic relevant to family medicine.
- Submissions must be of original work.
- Projects previously presented at medical schools or student “Research Days” are acceptable. Concurrent submissions to other conferences are considered legitimate and are, in fact, encouraged.
- The person submitting the poster must be a member of the Kansas Academy of Family Physicians.

SUBMISSION FORMAT:

Cover Sheet - One cover sheet (Page 2) should be completed for each submission.

Abstract - Submit one copy of an abstract of your poster. The abstract should be no longer than 250 words. Headings: Abstracts for research should be organized with headings such as: Background / Introduction; Methods; Results; Discussion / Conclusion. Abstracts of case reports and literature reviews may be organized with alternate headings as applicable.

REVIEW OF ABSTRACTS:

Abstracts will be reviewed by trustees of the KAFP-F. Authors submitting abstracts that are accepted for the Poster Presentation will be notified and will be expected to present their poster on the morning of Saturday, June 16, 2018 in Overland Park. Details of timing will be included in the acceptance letter. Students & residents are invited to participate in the Annual Meeting program for the rest of the morning with no registration fee.

PRESENTATION FORMAT:

Poster presentation –KAFP will provide a foam core board for your poster and clips to attach your poster.

STIPENDS:

The KAFP-Foundation will graciously provide funding for a \$100 participation stipend for each student & resident selected to participate. In addition, for students (sorry, not for residents or active members) who live more than 60 miles away from the conference hotel, KAFP will provide a room for Friday night in the conference hotel.
