

KANSAS PUBLIC HEALTH FELLOWSHIP

THE OPPORTUNITY:

An eight month fellowship offered by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment for up to 20 participants to support a greater understanding of the public health environment in Kansas as well as the expansion of leadership skills critical for effective public health planning and practice. Participation is free and includes coverage of some travel expenses.

WHO SHOULD PARTICIPATE?

Anyone working in a public health position (clinical or non-clinical) who has an interest in expanding their understanding of the Kansas public health system and how to help their organization meet its mission. Staff within organizations who contract with the Kansas Statewide Farmworker Health Program (or would like to!) are encouraged to apply.
