## **PURPOSE & TARGET**

Fortunately, most people in the US are vaccinated and don't get vaccine-preventable diseases, yet they still occur. Deaths from these diseases are not nearly as common as they were before vaccines. However, worldwide, including the United States over 3 million deaths from vaccine-preventable diseases occur annually.

Barriers affecting vaccination rates include lack of knowledge, fear of pain, cost, inadequate record-keeping, time and transportation issues and anti-vaccination messages. Barriers must be addressed and immunization rates must improve or we will begin to see an increase in the incidence of disease and death.

If there is one thing we know for sure, it's that VACCINES WORK!
