Membership Renewal Update; 2020 KAFP Membership Benchmark Numbers Released

Did you know that you can pay your 2020 dues with [Quick Pay](#)? Your membership renewal is appreciated. AAFP has made the following changes to [CME requirements due to COVID-19](#)

- AAFP members whose CME re-election cycle ends on Dec. 31, 2020, who have not met the requirement, will have an additional year to fulfill their CME requirement.
- Members whose CME re-election cycle ended on Dec. 31, 2019 will now have until Dec. 31, 2020 to report their CME, which they earned prior to Dec. 31, 2019, to remain eligible for membership

(original deadline was May 5, 2020).

- Any members who have not yet paid their 2020 dues will now have until July 14, 2020 to do so.

The AAFP Board of Directors has established two benchmark dates when citing official AAFP membership totals (February 28 for active and residents; April 30 for students and any other categories).
