New Sports Physical Forms and What You Need to Know

The Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA) preparticipation physical exam form has been updated based on the most recent edition of the PPE: Preparticipation Physical Evaluation, 5th Edition publication. **Download here**. The updated edition was developed by the American Academy of Family Physicians among other supporting organizations.

The new form, which went into effect May 1, is more in-depth, taking longer to complete. It is recommended that you review the form prior to administering your first sports physical. The history portion should be filled out *before* the student arrives in the office. Advise your staff that they must tell the parents – before the student athlete arrives in the office – that they MUST have the form filled out before the student is seen, otherwise this could interrupt your work flow during the patient visit.
