AAFP Launches New Website Aug. 17 - Update Your Email by Aug. 13

All AAFP websites will be unavailable beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Aug. 13 through Aug. 17 in preparation for the new AAFP website and mobile app which will launch on Aug. 17. If you need assistance from AAFP during this time, you can contact the Member Resource Center at AAFP@AAFP.org or 800-274-2237.

Your email address will be your default username for both the website and mobile app. To make sure you have access to the changes as soon as they're available, take a few moments to confirm that the AAFP has your preferred email address on file no later than **noon CDT on Thursday, Aug. 13** Just visit **AAFP.org**, click "My Account" under "Member Services" and check the email address listed under your name. You can change it by selecting "Edit Personal Info," entering your email address and clicking "Save My Account" at the bottom of the screen.

If you're using a shared email address (such as a generic practice address) that is also used by other AAFP members, you will need to add a unique email address by the Aug. 13 deadline to receive immediate access. To change from a shared address after that date, email the **AAFP Member Resource Center.**

Once the new website is live, look for an email from no-reply@aafp.org on Aug. 24 with instructions to reset your password.

A new collaboration between the AAFP and <u>Project N95</u> will help Academy members secure personal protective equipment -- even in hard-to-find small quantities -- during a limited-time opportunity beginning later this month.

Start planning now for the purchase opportunity, which will be open from Aug. 24 through Sept. 2. All AAFP members (including students and residents) will be able to purchase items such as N95 masks, gowns and face shields. Orders must be shipped within the United States.

This is being offered as a benefit for AAFP members and the Academy will not profit. Helping family physicians secure PPE has been a crucial part of the AAFP's government and private-sector advocacy from the beginning of the pandemic. Project N95 has certified the quality of the products being offered, and there is no minimum purchase requirement.
