About the Award

The KAFP Foundation is proud to open applications for the Student Leader in Family Medicine Award. This award is designed to honor third-year medical students from any of the three University of Kansas Medical Schools, with plans of going into family medicine. In 2022, two award recipients will be identified and presented with a \$250 award.

Award Criteria

- Third-year medical students at KU School of Medicine on the Wichita, Salina or Kansas City campuses are eligible.
- Applicant has plans of pursuing family medicine residency.
- Application must be a KAFP member in good standing.

Timeline

- Complete applications are due to KAFP by **May 20, 2022**.
- Applicants will be notified of the results in May. Award checks will be mailed to the recipients by the end of June.
- Recipients will be recognized (in name and photo) at KAFP's *Fam Med Forward* June 2-4, 2022.

This application consists of three essay questions and a letter of recommendation. You may type your essay responses on the following pages. Make sure to attach your letter of recommendation when submitting your application for consideration.

Essay 1: Describe your leadership experience in medical school, within Kansas Academy of Family Physicians, or within your community. (250 word limit)

Essay 2: What are your goals for after you complete your medical training? (250 word limit)

Essay 3: What is it about family medicine that excites you? (250 word limit)

Letter of Recommendation: Include a letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the family medicine department of your campus *OR* a practicing family physician you have experience with.

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
